

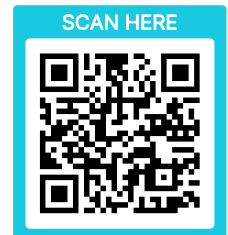

# LAUNCH DAY READINESS:

3 easy steps for existing users to get ready for CAMP 2.0.

## 1 Locate your Allergen Search Codes and write them down.

Your Allergen Search Codes are the two codes given to you by your provider after your patch testing was completed. These codes are unique to you and contain information about your specific allergens. **You will need access to these codes the first time you register as a new user.**

**Note: Existing CAMP iOS (Apple) app users will have search codes transferred to the upgraded CAMP automatically.**

### Locating Search Codes

Try looking here first:

1. On the upper right-hand corner of your printed/PDF Safe List.
2. Check your email for a message from donotreply@proximo.com for the original PDF version of your safe list, emailed to you around the time of your final patch test reading.
3. The after-visit summary from your patch testing appointment.
4. Your personal notes or medical papers.

If you are still unable to find your codes, contact your provider for assistance.

## 3 Prepare to access CAMP 2.0 on your mobile device or desktop on launch day.

CAMP 2.0 will be available for both iOS and Android devices and desktop browsers. Check out the specific instructions for each option below:



Once CAMP 2.0 is released:

- Tap on the current CAMP app. You will receive a notice from the App Store that a new version of the app is available.
- Follow the system instructions to complete the update.
- Open the app and complete the New Patient Registration link.
- Your existing search codes will **automatically transfer** to your new account.



Once CAMP 2.0 is released:

- Visit the Google Play store to download the app.
- Follow the system instructions to complete the download.
- Open the app and select the New Patient Registration link.
- When prompted, **enter your search codes.**

**Note: Please remove the existing Android CAMP app from your device before downloading CAMP 2.0.**

## SYSTEM UPGRADES: EXCITING NEW FEATURES IN CAMP 2.0

### Wondering why a product isn't appearing on your Safe List?

CAMP 2.0 expands beyond **Safe Lists** to include **Unsafe Lists**. Users can now search all products to see if they are safe to use, making it easier to understand why a product might be unsafe. Safe ingredients always appear in **green**, while unsafe ingredients appear in **red**.

#### Safe

##### Ingredients

Water, Glycerin, Mineral Oil, Cetyl Alcohol, Sorbitol, Caprylic/Capric Triglyceride, Emulsifying Wax, Palmitic Acid, Phenoxyethanol, Stearic Acid, Cetearyl Alcohol, Lecithin, Carbomer, Sodium Hydroxide, Ceteareth-20, Caprylyl Glycol, Sodium Citrate, Tocopheryl Acetate, Panthenol, Citric Acid, Avena Sativa Kernel Oil (Oat), Titanium Dioxide.

#### Unsafe

##### Ingredients

Talc, Diphenyl Dimethicone/Vinyl Diphenyl Dimethicone/ Silsesquioxane Crosspolymer, Polyethylene, Synthetic Fluoropolymer, Octyldodecyl Stearoyl Stearate, Mica, Nylon-12, Magnesium Myristate, Phenyl Trimethicone, Silica, Ethylhexylglycerin, **Parfum (Fragrance)**, Sorbic Acid, **Limonene**, **LINALOOL**, **Hexyl Cinnamal**, **Benzyl Salicylate**, Tocopherol, Citronellol, **Helianthus Annuus (Sunflower) Seed Oil**, Citral.

### Want to quickly see if a product is in CAMP?


Use the convenient **Scan** feature in the mobile app to scan a product UPC bar code. If it's in CAMP, the product listing will appear with information on whether it's safe or unsafe to use. Look for the "scan" icon in the app.



### Find a product in CAMP you want to buy?

Easily find and purchase safe products in CAMP with online retailers like Amazon, Walgreens, CVS, Target, and Walmart through the **Purchase Now** option. Look for the "Purchase" button on the product screen on the website or in the app.

 **Ingredients listed on products can be updated at any time. Always double check the ingredients listed on the actual product before purchasing.**

### Wondering if your symptoms are getting better or worse?

The **Quality of Life** feature allows you to track how your allergic contact dermatitis is affecting your life over time. Recording your scores periodically will help identify your progress. A higher score means your skin disease is negatively impacting your quality of life. Update your score in "My Profile" by clicking on the "Update Quality of Life" button.

Add or remove frequently used products to your favorites list for quick access.

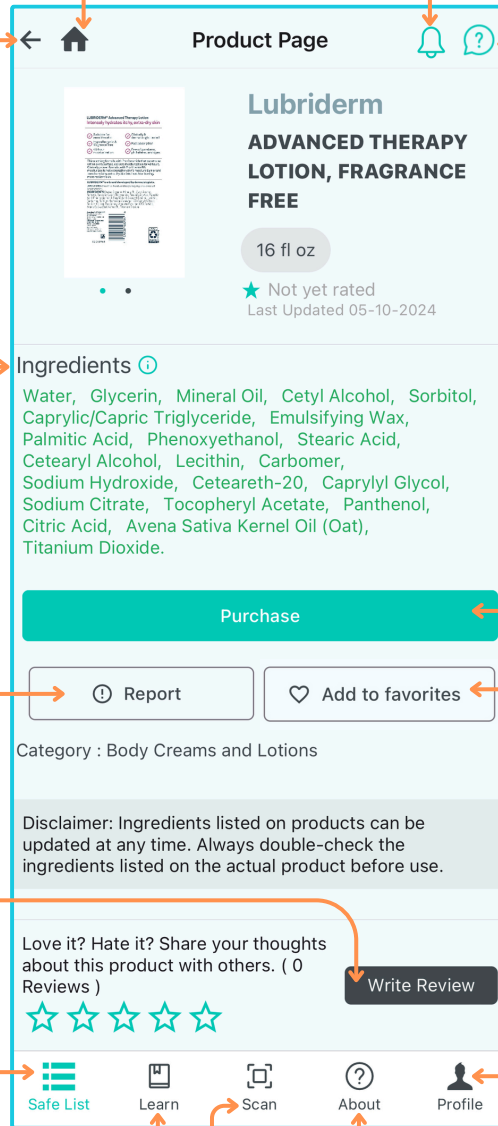
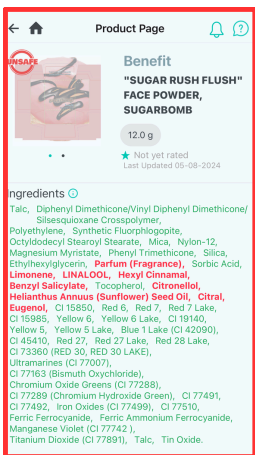
