CAMP 1.0 GOES OFFLINE

The CAMP 1.0 website and app will go offline at 10:00 PM EDT Friday, September 27th and is expected to last through the weekend. If you are a current CAMP 1.0 user, you will not have access to your safe list either on your computer, or through the app on your phone until September 30th.

CAMP 2.0 IS AVAILABLE

The new CAMP 2.0 website and app will go live at **7:00 AM EDT Monday, September 30th**. CAMP 2.0 is now **available on both iOS and Android** mobile devices and computer. Visit the ACDS website online for assistance with updating your app and logging in for the first time.

Your Allergen Search Codes are the two codes given to you by your provider after your patch testing was completed. These codes are unique to you and contain information about your specific allergens. You will need access to these codes the first time you register as a

Locating Search Codes

Try looking here first:

1. On the upper right-hand corner of your printed/PDF Safe List.

- 2. Check your email for a message from donotreply@proximo.com for the original PDF version of your safe list, emailed to you around the time of your final patch test reading.
- 3. The after-visit summary from your patch testing appointment.
- 4. Your personal notes or medical papers.

If you are still unable to find your codes, contact your provider for assistance.

Prepare to access CAMP 2.0 on your mobile device or desktop on launch day.

CAMP 2.0 will be available for both iOS and Android devices and desktop browsers. Check out the specific instructions for each option below:



iOS

Once CAMP 2.0 is released:

- Tap on the current CAMP app. You will receive a notice from the App Store that a new version of the app is available.
- · Follow the system instructions to complete the update.
- Open the app and complete the New Patient Registration link.
- Your existing search codes will automatically transfer to your new account.



Android

Once CAMP 2.0 is released:

- Visit the Google Play store to download the app.
- Follow the system instructions to complete the download.
- Open the app and select the New Patient Registration link.
- · When prompted, enter your search codes.

Desktop

Once CAMP 2.0 is released:

- Visit www.acdscamp.org.
- · Select the New Patient Registration link.
- When prompted, enter your search codes.

Wondering why a product isn't appearing on your Safe List?

CAMP 2.0 expands beyond **Safe Lists** to include **Unsafe Lists**. Users can now search all products to see if they are safe to use, making it easier to understand why a product might be unsafe. Safe ingredients always appear in green, while unsafe ingredients appear in **red**.

Want to quickly see if a product is in CAMP?

Use the convenient **Scan** feature in the mobile app to scan a product UPC bar code. If it's in CAMP, the product listing will appear with information on whether it's safe or unsafe to use. Look for the "scan" icon in the app.


Wondering if your symptoms are getting better or worse?
